



SOLUTIONS TO ASSIST GULF DISASTER EFFORTS

If you feel that your business can offer assistance towards the BP Gulf Oil Spill, businesses can submit their inquiries through the various channels listed below:

- If your technology solution is an alternative response technology or directly related to the wellhead, you should contact the response team directly at 281-366-5511, or via the response unified command website at: <http://www.deepwaterhorizonresponse.com/go/doc/2931/546759/>.
- You can also submit your innovative and environmentally safe technology solutions related to the Deepwater Horizon oil spill through our website at <http://www.epa.gov/bpspill/techsolution.html>. EPA's technical experts will review your submission and will contact you directly if necessary.
- If your product is a dispersant, surface washing or surface cleaning agent, bioremediation product, or sorbent, it must be evaluated through a regulatory process that has been designed to assess the performance, including potential environmental impacts, of your product before it can be used in this or any other spill response. - If your product is already listed on the National Contingency Plan Product Schedule (<http://www.epa.gov/emergencies/docs/oil/ncp/schedule.pdf>), please note that you do not need to submit any additional information.
